一、公文寫作(函)【配分30分】

全國農業金庫的成立宗旨,主要在建構農業金融體系,輔導並協助農會、漁會信用部事業發展,辦理 農、林、漁、牧融資及穩定農業金融,促進農業經濟發展。

該公司組織系統,包括董事會、監察人會,總公司及營業單位。總公司置總經理1人,副總經理2~3 人,下設財務部、信託部、業務發展部、專業金融部、行政管理部、資訊室及會計室等7個單位。國內營 業單位包括營業部、臺中分行及高雄分行共3個營業據點。

該公司民國104年業務發展計畫,在「輔導農漁會信用部業務」方面,其中之一為:輔導農漁會信用 部落實內部控制與稽核制度。本計畫乃依據行政院農業委員會函示,自民國103年起,針對農漁會信用部 稽核人員一般查核報告辦理實地查核,就其缺失輔導改善,並於民國104年就辦理情形進行檢討,另一併 修正信用部查核報告(含工作底稿),以輔導信用部落實內控,健全經營。
