## 第一篇:

Pothos plants are one of the most popular houseplants. They aren't fussy about light or water or fertilization and when it comes to how to propagate a pothos, the answer is as easy as the node on the stem. Pothos propagation begins with the root nodes on the stem right below the leaf or branch junctures. These tiny bumps on the stems of rooting pothos are the key to propagating pothos. When an aging plant begins to get leggy or a full and healthy plant grows too long, simply give the plant a haircut.

To begin the process of propagation, one will snip off 4-to 6-inch lengths of healthy stem for the pothos cuttings, making sure each cutting has four or more leaves. Then, the leaf that is closest to the cut end needs to be removed. Once the stems are cut, they' re ready to begin rooting. Pothos propagation can be accomplished in two ways. One might want to try both to see which one works best.

The first method of propagating pothos is to place the cut ends of the stems in water. An old glass or jelly jar is perfect for rooting pothos. The jar of pothos cuttings needs to be put in a place that gets plenty of light, but not direct sunlight. About a month after the roots begin to show, one can plant the cuttings in soil and treat them as one would any other houseplant. Be careful though, the longer pothos cuttings remain in water, the harder time they have adapting to soil. It is best to transplant rooted pothos cuttings as soon as they start roots.

The preferred method of how to propagate a pothos begins the same as the first. Take the pothos cuttings and remove the first leaf above the cut ends. Dip the cut end in rooting hormone. Make sure the first set of root nodes is covered. Set the cuttings in a potting mixture of half peat moss and half perlite or sand. Keep the soil moist and keep the rooting pothos out of direct sunlight. Roots should develop after one month; and after two or three months, the new plants will be ready.

## 第二篇:

Even though Japan and France are the two countries that enjoy highspeed today, their highspeed rail systems are technically different.

The French TGV and Japanese Shinkansen were designed for different geographic and traffic demands. A close lookat the map of both these systems will tell you that Shinkansen, as the name itself suggests, was envisioned like a huge backbone from which smaller branches branch out to connect the entire country. It passes through a series of urban agglomerations henceencountering frequent stops throughout the line. The hilly terrain of Japan means it will have more curves and tunnels comparatively which affect the train design as have been seen. The geography of Japan also supports a track route of such a nature. The French TGV lines, on the other hand, is designed in a way that the corners of the country are well connected with its capital city, Paris. And as TGV map suggests, the lines are not so densely populated as in Japan.

Shinkansen trains are designed to run full of people. It is not that the TGV cannot run in full capacity. But the number of seats required in Shinkansen is significantly much larger than that seen in TGV's. The first seven of the highest number of people that can be accommodated per meter all belong to Shinkansen, with a capacity per unit length between 3 and 4 people every meter of train length. The best train in the series from the TGV series comes at 8th with over 2.5 people per meter of the train. This means there is more space and comfort for travelers in TGV as compared to the Shinkansen trains. This leads to a possibility of capacity of about 1,200 people per trainset in case of Shinkansen trains while TGV trainset supports over 500 people per trainset.
