The mood of executives at retail firms normally moves in 41 with that of their customers. But in America , the news on May 25th that consumer confidence had reached its highest level in two years left them oddly subdued. Consumer spending per person , which fell for two years 42 for the first time since the Depression last year and the year before , has been rising again in recent months. But as retail executives place orders for the crucial end-of-year rush , they are anxiously debating how strong and lasting the consumer's 43 will be.

In the first quarter , both fancier retailers such as Gap , Macy's and Saks and 44 ones like Target , Wal-Mart and Home Depot all announced improved results. The 45 has been strongest in luxury stores : same-store sales at Neiman Marcus , for example , were 11% higher this April than last. But there was also reason for cheer at Home Depot , which relies on humbler consumers and the still-low housing market : revenues were up by 4.3% on the first quarter of 2009.

Not so long ago , all fibers used to make textiles came from natural sources : wool from the hair of sheep, cotton from the cotton plant , silk from silk worms . The first true synthetic fiber didn't appear until 1935 , when scientists at the DuPont Company invented nylon. Nylon is just one of various industrially produced substances called polymers. Polymers can be pulled into a thread , which makes them well suited for use in textile manufacturing.

Synthetic textiles have come a long way since nylon. Kevlar , a textile which is stronger than steel , is used in bulletproof vests and ropes used by astronauts in space. Other high-tech fibers can resist very high temperatures-- perfect for firefighters and race-car drivers. While not all companies are forthcoming about their products for fear of having their ideas stolen , Huges Vinchon , an executive at Dubar-Warneton , a manufacturer of high-tech textiles in France , is happy to display some of the amazing synthetic fibers his company creates. There is an Oil-eating textile that absorbs five times its weight in Oil , and is perfect for cleaning up Oil spills. There is also an ordinary-looking cloth bag that is " completely water soluble ," according to Vinchon. " It's strong enough to carry heavy objects. But if I dip it in boiling water , it disappears."
