Not so long ago, all fibers used to make textiles came from natural sources: wool from the hair of sheep, cotton from the cotton plant, silk from silk worms. The first true synthetic fiber didn't appear until 1935, when scientists at the DuPont Company invented nylon. Nylon is just one of various industrially produced substances called polymers. Polymers can be pulled into a thread, which makes them well suited for use in textile manufacturing.

Synthetic textiles have come a long way since nylon. Kevlar, a textile which is stronger than steel, is used in bulletproof vests and ropes used by astronauts in space. Other high-tech fibers can resist very high temperatures-perfect for firefighters and race-car drivers. While not all companies are forthcoming about their products for fear of having their ideas stolen, Huges Vinchon, an executive at Dubar-Warneton, a manufacturer of high-tech textiles in France, is happy to display some of the amazing synthetic fibers his company creates. There is an Oil-eating textile that absorbs five times its weight in Oil, and is perfect for cleaning up Oil spills. There is also an ordinary-looking cloth bag that is "completely water soluble," according to Vinchon. "It's strong enough to carry heavy objects. But if I dip it in boiling water, it disappears."
